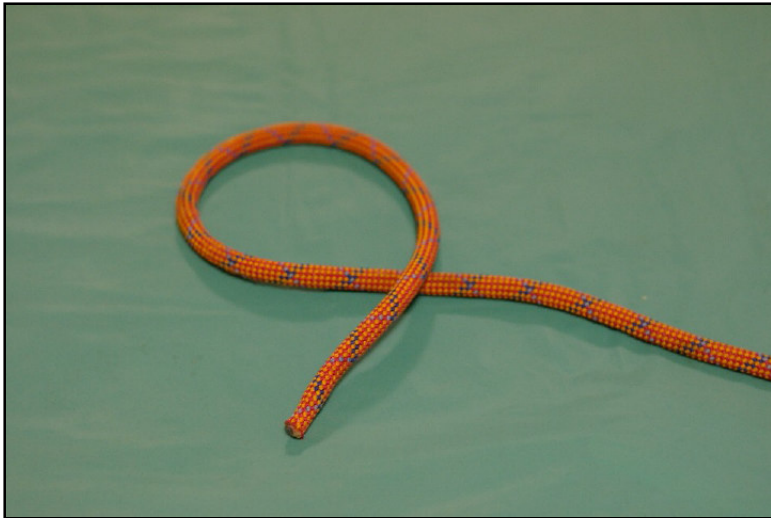




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1. Make a simple loop in the end of the rope.



2. Make a bight and pass it through the loop.



3. Pull tight.



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4a. Make a second bite.



4b. Pass this bite through the first bite.



5. Continue to "daisy chain" bites until there are 5 loops showing.



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6a. Make another bite.



6b. Insert bite down and perpendicular to "daisy chain".



7. Continue across all 5 loops of the "daisy chain".



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8. Start the second row by passing a bite under the last bite of the previous row.



9. Continue passing bites under to form the second row,



10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 to continue forming rows.



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11. When 3' from the end of the rope, make a bite and pass it through the previous bite.



12. Continue stitching across by passing bites through.

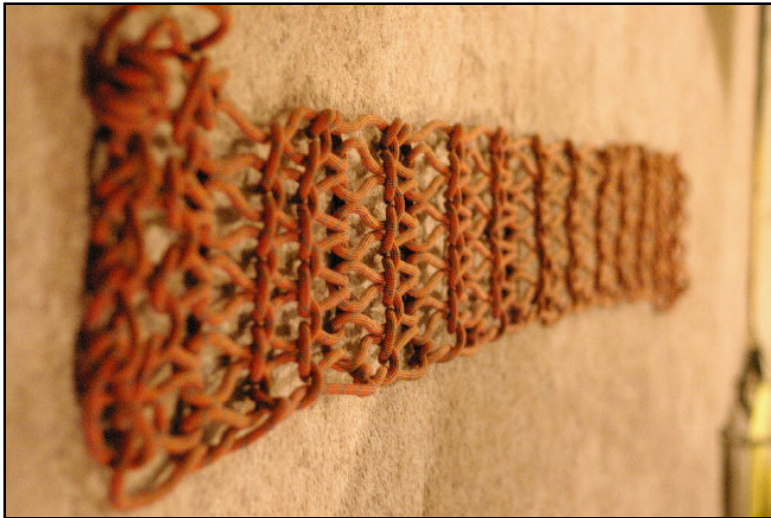


13. When you reach the end of the row. Tie off the end of the rope.
